This course focuses on how to use and apply specification language and proper construction details to create successful projects that meet the designer and owner's expectations for color, general appearance, and moisture penetration resistance.

- 2. How to specify masonry sample panels on projects to serve both as a communication tool and as a standard to ensure that the project is built in compliance with the designer's aesthetic and quality requirements.
- 3. How masonry coatings can be specified as an effective means to resist moisture penetration and enhance aesthetic appearance of masonry wall assemblies.
- 4. How to specify and detail various flashing and weep systems in masonry wall assemblies for moisture penetration resistance.
